Slalom

The Slalom World Championships (Men) were held in Texel, Netherlands in June.
World Champion – Bernd Flessner (GER)

The Slalom Youth & Masters World Championship was held in Curacao in April
Youth World Champion - Gutek Kurczewski (POL)
Masters – unfortunately it was not possible to run the final.

The Slalom Womens World Championship took place in Hyere, France, in September.
World Champion – Delphine Cousin (FRA)

The following Continental Championships were held:
South Americans – Buzios, Brasil, in February
Oceanics – Dunedin, New Zealand, also in February
European (JYM) – Hyere, France, in September
North Americans – Miami, USA, in late October

Freestyle

The Pro Kids and Junior & Youth World Championships were organized in Brouwersdam, Netherlands in July.
Junior World Champion – Rafael de Windt (CUR)
Youth World Champion - Rick Jendrusch (NED)

The European Championship was sanctioned through the EFPT (European Freestyle Pro Tour) and has one event to be completed on the tour calendar.
It is a similar situation on the EFPKT – the junior and youth tour sanctioned to give European titles.
