



## **2013 Report from the International Funboard Class Association to the ISAF Windsurfing & Kiteboarding Committee**

**Membership** - 24 countries, representing 5 continents.

Interest in funboard competition, in all disciplines, is healthy, and is still growing particularly in slalom.

### **Slalom**

The Slalom World Championship (Men) was held on Sylt, Germany, in May.  
World Champion – Gunnar Asmussen (Germany)

The Slalom Youth & Masters World Championships were held in Alacati, Turkey, in July.  
Youth World Champion – Akay Poyraz (Turkey)  
Masters world Champion – Andrea Rosati (Italy)

A South American Slalom and Wave Championships took place in Pacasmayo, Peru, in August. The combination of disciplines at events seems to be a winning format particularly for continental championships and may be expanded.  
South American wave and slalom champion – Wilhelm Schurmann (Brasil).

### **Freestyle**

The Junior & Youth Championships were organized in Marseille, France in June.  
Champion – Steven Max (ARU)

The European Championship was sanctioned through the EFPT (European Freestyle Pro Tour) – this years tour has yet to be completed

The European Junior and Youth Championships takes place in Croatia in November.
