  - i) It is proposed by the Class Committee to amend Class Rule C.8.1.b) Size

Woman	Maximum	<del>8.5</del> m2	<mark>8.500</mark> m2
Youths	Maximum	<del>8.5</del> m2	<mark>8.500</mark> m2

- ii) It is proposed by FRA RB Association to limit Junior sailors to a maximum sail size of 8.500 m2.
- iii) It is proposed by FRA RB to limit Junior men to a maximum sail size of 8.500 m2 and Youth/Junior women to a maximum sail size of 7.800 m2.
- iv) It is proposed by the Class Chairman to add new rule to limit board volume to 331 litres.
- v) It is proposed by the ESP RB Association to allow the registration of 3 sails by Veteran sailors.

#### Class Championship Rules (CCR) Submissions - see AGM Appendix 6

- i) Age Division restructure a proposal from Class Chairman.
  (a) CCR 2.2.1 Youth (C) is a man or woman who is less than 20-19 years old.
  - (b) CCR 2.2.2 Master (D) is a man or woman who has reached the age 35 40, or a woman who has reached the age of 30;
  - (c) CCR 2.2.3 Grand Master (E) is a man or woman who has reached the age of 45 50, or a woman who has reached the age of 40.
  - (d) CCR 2.2.4 Veteran (F) is a man or woman who has reached the age of 55 60, or a woman who has reached the age of age of 50.
  - (e) CCR 2.2.5 Super Veteran (G) is a man who has reached the age of 65, or a woman who has reached the age of 60.
  - (f) ADD new age division Junior is a man or woman who is less than 23 years old.
  - (g) ADD new definition Senior is a man or woman who has reached the age of 23.
  - (h) If approved the numbering shall be amended accordingly.
- ii) Marathon Rules a proposal from the Class Chairman. (a) A Marathon Race shall be scored as 2 races.

# i) Additional financing for Class Championships

It is proposed by ESP RB Association to set up of a working group that can attempt to find alternative financing for international events (sponsoring, public grants, fundraising, etc) which may lead to a reduction in class event entry fees.

ii) Incentives to attract female competitors

It is proposed by ESP RB Association that "in order to promote the woman fleet in international events, reduce the entry fees for them at these events."

iii) Student Championships

It is proposed by the FRA RB Association that the class look at all possibilities to increase participation from the 18>25 year age group.
