The topics:

Redress Policy - presented by the Jury.

Mixed feelings from gathered coaches.

Mike suggested to have a presentation of the Policy at the Europeans to be voted at the next AGM

Back to back (B2B) Races

Unanimously for three B2B for both Junior and Youth (depending on circumstances)

That means we need to keep short races, like we do now.

Practice race

We keep it. It is absolutely necessary for many reasons: CC, security, organisation ...

It's a good idea to make it attractive for racers, maybe think of prizes, lycra ceremony or ... for the winners

Number of racing days

Most coaches seem in favour to reduce championships to 5 days (End on Friday evening)

And if we keep 6 days, change to have 15 races maximum and not 12.

Fin

A submission will need to be made to the next AGM to allow the possibility to use 50 cm fin with the 7.8 sail

Kill cords emphasis

Equipment issues
