1 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing – [Windsurfing Edition \(WCR\)](#).
- 1.2 The Techno 293 Class Rules and Championship Rules will apply.
- 1.3 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between these Sailing Instructions and any other document governing the event, the Sailing Instructions will take precedence.
This changes WCR 63.7.
- 1.6 Every competitor will be required to carry on their person, not attached to their equipment, a tracking device supplied by the organisation during every race.

2 ADVERTISING

Boards may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. World Sailing Regulation 20 'Advertising Code' shall apply.

3 DIVISIONS

- 3.1 **The participating age divisions shall be:**
 - 3.1.1 Techno 293 - Junior Boy & Girl.
A Junior shall be under 15 years of age (born in 2006 and not later than 2010).
 - 3.1.2 Techno 293 – Youth Boy & Girl.
A Youth shall be under 17 years of age (born in 2004 and not later than 2008).
- 3.2 **Age Sub-Division:**
 - 3.2.1 T293 U13 shall be under 13 years of age (born in 2008, but not later than 2010).
- 3.2 A minimum of 5 competitors is required to constitute a division or sub-division.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 Entries shall meet the requirements of World Sailing Regulation 19-Eligibility Code.
- 4.2 Competitors shall be members of a National Class Association which is a paid up member of the international class association, or of the IWA. Membership formalities can be completed on site.
- 4.3 Eligible competitors may [enter online](#) - credit/debit card or bank transfer payment required. **On-line entry will close on 17th October 2020.**
- 4.4 A competitor entry is not valid until the entry fee is paid.
- 4.5 The following shall be presented upon registration:
 - Evidence of valid third party insurance
 - Proof of age
 - **Parental Permission Form**
- 4.6 Support personnel may [register online](#) - credit/debit card or bank transfer payment required).
The following shall be presented upon registration:
 - Boat Driving Licence (if applicable)
 - Evidence of valid third party insurance

5 ENTRY FEES

- 5.1 The required competitor entry fee is 240 euro.
- 5.2 Competitor entry fees paid by **26th September** shall receive a **40 euro discount**.

- 5.3 Payments received after the 17th October and late entries accepted after 17th October may be surcharged 20 euro.
- 5.4 A fee of 50 euro is required for support personnel.
- 5.5 Entry fees paid at registration shall be paid in cash - Euros.

6 RACE FORMAT

- 6.1 The Championship shall be a *racing*, "open entry" event.
- 6.2 Boys and girls may race together depending upon entry numbers.
- 6.3 Competitors shall race a maximum 4 races per day, in a maximum of 15 race event.
- 6.4 Three races are required to validate the championship for each division.

7 SCHEDULE

- 7.2 The daily race schedule and the scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race will be posted on the Official Notice board, except on the 25th October when the first warning signal for a practice race will be made at 14:00.

8 EQUIPMENT & EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 8.1 An [Equipment Inspection Form](#) shall be completed and returned to the Event Equipment Inspectors by the close of registration.
- 8.2 Equipment inspections may be made at any time during the event.
- 8.3 Upon completion of registration and until the end of the event, at all times when ashore except when launching and retrieving from the designated area, all equipment shall be kept in their assigned places at event site. Removal of any equipment from the event site requires prior written approval from the race committee. Access to equipment in the storage area during certain hours, including hours of darkness may be restricted.

8.4 Each racing day every competitor will be issued with a tracking device, which shall be returned to the distribution desk at the end of each day.

9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions (SI's) will be available no later than event registration. Any changes to the SI's shall be approved by the Class Representative at the event.

10 COURSES

Courses will be as described in the sailing instructions.

11 INTERNATIONAL JURY

An International Jury may be appointed in accordance with WCR Appendix N. There shall be no appeal from their decisions in accordance with WCR 70.5.

12 SCORING

Scoring will be according to the WCR Appendix A. Championship Rules apply when Group Racing within divisions.

13 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be registered at the race office. For coach boat charter please contact Circolo Surf Torbole office: segreteria@circolosurftorbole.com

Support boat drivers shall have a valid boat licence and 3rd party liability insurance.

Private motor boats are not permitted on this section of the lake without the "temporary permission" granted through the host club.

An assigned berth will be provided for the support boats by the local organizer

14 SAFETY

14.1 Personal buoyancy is mandatory for every competitor and support boat crew member.

14.2 Every competitor and support boat crew member shall wear a personal flotation device that shall conform to the minimum standard of ISO 12402-5 (level 50), or as specified in the SI's.

14.3 Coach and support boat drivers shall use the kill cord in the recommended manner.

15 PRIZES

15.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first three competitors of each constituted division.

15.2 The first Junior boy and girl shall be known as the – **2020 Techno 293 Junior World Champion.**

15.3 The first Youth boy and girl shall be known as the – **2020 Techno 293 Youth World Champion.**

15.4 Winners in the T293 U13 Sub-division shall be decided by their positions in the T293 Junior overall ranking.

16 OFFICIAL CEREMONIES

Competitors are requested to attend the event's social functions; however, the organising authority may refuse entry to those whose standard of attire is not commensurate with the occasion. **Prize winners may forfeit prizes for non- attendance at the prize giving ceremony.**

17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk, see WCR 4 - Decision to Race. The organising authority or any of their officials or representatives or the sponsors or their officials or representatives will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.

18 INSURANCE

Each participating board shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1,500,000 euro per event or the equivalent.

19 RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In registering for the event, competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproduction of them, taken during the period of the event, for the said Event as defined in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions in which he/she participates without compensation.
