1a) What is freestyle classix

- Freestyle Classix is a big freestyle show with personalities of the windsurf sport
- The target is to bring the best windsurfers of the past back 10 years into an event format which transports “fun, surf style, beach life” to the spectators
- It is not a masters tour! We just freeze the level in freestyle - so that the masters and the youngsters can achieve the necessary level in a short time
- Style will be more important than just doing tricks



1b) Freestyle moves & judging

- **Riding moves:** 360, backwind jibe, bodydrag, duck jibe, duck tack, heli tack, push tack, reverse duck jibe, sail body 360, slam jibe, speed jibe, upwind 360,
- **Air moves:** back loop, cheese roll, chop hop, front loop, high jump, jump one handed, one footer, spin loop, table top, wymaroo, shove it
- **Rotation moves:** arial jibe, air jibe, spock, spock 540, Willi Skipper

All maneuvers will have the same degree of difficulty. The judges will judge the overall impression with a big focus on the surf style.

The riders will have to show a variety of maneuvers out of all 3 categories. Also the wind- and water conditions have to be taken into account (i.e. in low wind conditions it makes more sense to show riding moves on a big slalom board and a big sail instead of showing jumps only few inches high)

1c) Event format

- We do not want to invent everything new, so we will run a traditional double elimination format (48 riders maximum)
- The top 24 riders of the EFPT will be qualified
- 24 wildcards
- Seeding will be based on the results achieved in the past 10 years
- Total prize money will be 10.000 Euro
- Wind limit: 11 knots
