Section 1 - Essential Information

OTHER BOARD(S). If you are claiming that a board or boards broke a rule and/or made your score worse, you must identify them: (The group and sail number of each board OR some other identification)

OTHER PARTIES. If you are claiming that your score was made worse by the action of a race official:

⚠ You **must** provide the following information before or during the hearing but doing so during the hearing may cause the hearing to be delayed.

TIME AND PLACE OF THE INCIDENT. Describe where and when the incident occurred (E.g. date, time or race number and leg of the course, etc.)

Section 3 – Additional Information

⚠ If you are claiming that a board or boards broke a rule, the rules say that you must inform them that you intend to protest, otherwise your hearing request will be invalid.

For an incident on the water, you must also inform the race committee at the finish.

It is not sufficient just to fill in this form.

If you have time, try to provide the information below. You will be asked to provide this information during the hearing

INFORMING OTHER BOATS. If you are claiming that a boat or boats broke a rule, have you informed them that you intend to protest? If 'yes', describe how and when.
