## 1. RULES

---

- 1.1. The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the **Windsurfing Slalom Racing Rules (WSRR)**.
- 1.2. No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.4. The International Funboard Class Association (IFCA) Championship Rules shall apply.
- 1.5. For this championship Class Rule C.2.3.(b) shall not apply.
- 1.6. In accordance with the recommendations of World Sailing, competitors of Russian and Belarusian nationality are excluded from this event, entries by such competitors will be rejected and any existing entries by such competitors are cancelled.

## 2. ADVERTISING

---

- 2.1. Sailors may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority. World Sailing Regulation 20 'Advertising Code' shall apply.
- 2.2. Event branding shall be worn at all times when afloat, and as requested by the organisers during media interviews and during the prize giving.

## 3. DIVISIONS

---

- 3.1. Age Divisions:
- 3.2. Youth shall be under the age of 21 (born in or after 2003).
- 3.3. Junior shall be under the age of 17 (born in or after 2007).
- 3.4. There may be additional prize divisions for junior under 15 and under 13 age groups, depending upon competitor entries.
- 3.5. A minimum of 5 competitors is required to constitute a prize division.
- 3.6. **This championship is for sailors in the FIN division only - see Class Rule C.6.1.**

#### 4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

---

- 4.1. Entries shall meet requirements of World Sailing Regulation 19-Eligibility Code.
- 4.2. Competitors shall be members of a National Class Association which is a paid up member of the international class association, or of the IWA.
- 4.3. The Italian competitors must have a valid card of the Italian Sailing Federation which includes a valid medical certificate, and a valid card of the AICW 2023(socio giovanile o silver slalom)
- 4.4. Eligible competitors may enter online - credit/debit card or bank transfer payment required. Online entry closes on 27<sup>th</sup> May 2023.
- 4.5. An entry is not valid until it is paid. Unpaid entries at close of online entry may be removed from the entry list.
- 4.6. The Maximum number of entries for Juniors & Youth's fleet is 80.
- 4.7. The following shall be presented upon registration:
  - Italian competitors must be in possession of the valid Fiv card including health provisions.
  - For all other crew members:
    - Either prove that he or she belongs to a World Sailing MNA, and holds a valid third party liability insurance with a cover of at least 1,5 million Euro,
    - Proof of age
    - **Parental Permission Form** - *for those under age of 18*

#### 5. FEES

---

- 5.1. The entry fee is: 190euro, except for Junior - 160euro.
- 5.2. A discount of 30 euro applies for entries received by 20 May 2023.
- 5.3. Late entries accepted at registration will incur a 20 euro surcharge.
- 5.4. Entry fees paid at registration shall be paid in cash (euro).

## 6. RACE FORMAT

---

- 6.1. The Championships shall be a single discipline, slalom racing, "open entry" event.
- 6.2. Men and women may race together.
- 6.3. Competitors may race a maximum 4 eliminations per day, except for the divisions that sail in single fleets who may race a maximum of 8 races per day.
- 6.4. One completed slalom elimination (including both A and B finals) is required to validate a championship.

## 7. SCHEDULE

---

- 7.2. There will be a daily skippers meeting 1 hour before first possible warning signal.

## 8. EQUIPMENT & EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

---

- 8.1. An **Online Equipment Inspection** Form shall be completed by each competitor and submitted before the end of registration on **Monday June 5th**.
- 8.2. Equipment inspections may be made at any time during the event.

**8.3.** Sail Identification Compliance. The Equipment Inspectors will pay attention to sail identification rule. A discretionary penalty of 1 point may be imposed for every slalom elimination sailed with sail numbers that are not complying.

**8.4.** Use of a FOIL is not permitted – see Class Rule C.6.1

## **9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

---

The sailing instructions (SI's) will be available upon registration. Any changes to the SI's shall be approved by the Class Representative.

## **10. COURSES**

---

Courses will be as described in the IFCA Championship Rules or as prescribed in the sailing instructions or published on the official notice board (ONB).

## **11. INTERNATIONAL JURY**

---

An International Jury may be appointed in accordance with WSRR Appendix N. There shall be no appeal from their decisions.

## **12. SCORING**

---

Scoring will be according to the WSRR Appendix A.

## **13. COACHES & SUPPORT BOATS**

---

Coaches and support boats shall be registered with the organiser. Support boat drivers shall have a valid boat licence and third party liability insurance.

## **14. SAFETY**

---

**14.1.** If personal buoyancy is prescribed every competitor and support boat crewmember shall wear a personal flotation device that shall conform to the minimum standard ISO 12402-5 (Level 50).

**14.2.** Every competitor shall wear a helmet at all times when afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment.

**14.3.** The helmet needs to comply with the minimum standard EN1385, EN1077, EN 966, ASTM 2040, Snell S98 or equivalent, with a brightly coloured region of at least 300 square centimetres of the exterior surface that can be seen from above the water with crew lying face down or face up.

**14.4.** The helmet should comply with:

- the minimum standards as prescribed
- be colored as prescribed in the Class rules C.3.2.b

## **15. PRIZES & TITLES**

---

- 15.1.** Trophies may be awarded to the first three competitors in each valid division.
- 15.2.** The first competitor in the championship ranking for Youth & Junior shall be declared: **“2023 IFCA (Youth/Junior) Slalom World Champion”**.
- 15.3.** The first competitor in the championship ranking for youth men shall be declared: **“2023 IFCA Youth Men Slalom World Champion”**.
- 15.4.** The first competitor in the championship ranking for youth women shall be declared: **“2023 IFCA Youth Women Slalom World Champion”**.
- 15.5.** The first competitor in the championship ranking for junior boy shall be declared: **“2023 IFCA Junior Boy Slalom World Champion.”**
- 15.6.** The first competitor in the championship ranking for junior girl shall be declared: **“2023 IFCA Junior Girl Slalom World Champion”**.

## **16. OFFICIAL CEREMONIES**

---

Competitors are requested to attend the event’s social functions; however, the organising authority may refuse entry to those whose standard of attire is not commensurate with the occasion. **Prize winners may forfeit prizes for non attendance at the prize giving ceremony.**

## **17. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

---

**Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk, see WSRR 4 - Decision to Race.** The Organising authority or any of their officials or representatives or the sponsors or their officials or representatives will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.

## **18. INSURANCE**

---

Each participating competitor shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1,500,000 euro per event or the equivalent.

## **19. RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS**

---

In registering for the event, competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use, modify and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproduction of them, taken during the period of the event, for the said Event as defined in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions in which he/she participates without compensation.
