1. RULES

- 1.1. The event will be governed by the rules as defined in 2021 2024 RACING RULES OF SAILING (Windsurfing Fleet Racing Edition) and The Class Rules of participating classes such as:
 - 1.1.1 The T293 & TPlus Class Rules
 - 1.1.2 The International Windsurfer (LT) Class Rule
 - 1.1.3 International IQ Foil Class Rules and related Wind foil Rules
 - 1.1.4 International Wing Foil Class Rules
- 1.2. No National Authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3. If there is conflict between the Class Rules and the Notice of Race, the Notice of Race will take precedence.
- 1.4. If there is conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions (SI's), the SI will take precedence.
- 1.5. If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

[NP] Boards may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

3.1. The participating classes and divisions shall be:

From 22/2/2024 to 25/2/2024:

- 3.1.1. **Techno 293 (T293)** Junior Boy & Girl; Youth Boy & Girl; Under 13
- 3.1.2. **Techno 293 Plus (TPlus)** Youth Man & Women; Open Man & Woman
- 3.1.3. **IQ Foil Junior** Junior Boy & Girl
- 3.1.4. **IQ Foil** Men, Women, Youth Boy & Girl

From 24/2/2024 to 25/2/2024:

- 3.1.5. **Wind Foil** Men, Women, Youth Boy & Girl, Masters, Grand Masters
- 3.1.6. Wing Foil Open
- 3.1.7. **RS:One** *Men, Women , Under 21*
- 3.1.8. **Windsurfer LT** Grand Master, Master, Man, Women
 - 3.2. **Age Divisions**:
- 3.2.1. A **T293 Junior and IQ Foil Junior** shall be under 15 years of age (born in or after 2010 but not later than 2014)
- 3.2.2. A **T293 Youth and Wind Foil Youth** shall be under 17 years of age (born in or after 2008 but not later than 2012).
- 3.2.3. A **TPlus Youth and IQ Foil Youth** competitor shall be under 19 years of age (born in or after 2006).
- 3.2.4. A **T293 U13** shall be under 13 years of age (born in or after 2012, but not later than 2014).
- 3.2.5. A **RS:One Under 21** shall be a man or woman born in or after 2004
- 3.2.6. A **Master** shall be between 40 -59 years of age in the year of competition (born between 1984 and 1965).
- 3.2.7. A **Grand Master** shall be 60 years of age or older, in the year of competition (born 1964 or earlier)

- 3.2.8. A minimum of 3 competitors is required to form a class.
 - a) Within a class, a minimum of 3 competitors is required to form a division
 - b) If there are insufficient competitors to form a division, all competitors will compete under a combined division within the class.
 - c) The organizing committee reserves the overall right to decide the final formation of divisions and classes for this event.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. [NP] Competitors shall be members of a National Class Association which is a current paidup member of the relevant international class association. Membership formalities can be completed on site.
- 4.2. Eligible competitors may register for the event (see item 19) by **time 23:59, date 21st December 2023, to enjoy early bird registration discounts.**

The following shall be presented upon registration:

- o Original Entry Form
- o Proof of age
- o Parental Permission Form-for competitors under the age of 18

5. FEES

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions (SI's) will be available upon registration. Any changes to the SI's shall be approved by the Organizing Committee and Class Representative

9. COURSES

Courses will be as described in the sailing instructions.

10. PROTEST COMMITTEE

An 'Independent Protest Committee' will be appointed.

11. SCORING

- 11.1. Scoring will be according to the WCR Appendix A, except as amended below for discards.
- 11.2. *For the Techno293 and Techno293 Plus,* there will be one discard after 4 races have been completed, and a second discard after 11 races have been completed.
- 11.3. For other classes:
- 11.3.1. When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores.
- 11.3.2. When 4 to 7 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 11.3.3. When 8 to 14 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.
- 11.3.4. When 15 or more races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her three worst scores.

12. SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be registered at the race office.

13. SAFETY

- 13.1 Every competitors and support boat crew member shall wear a personal flotation device that shall conform to the minimum standard of ISO 12402-5 (level 50), or as specified in the class rules.
- 13.2 All Foilers shall wear a helmet when racing at sea

14. PRIZES

14.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top three competitors of each properly constituted class /division.

14.2 **Prizes for T293 and TPlus**

- 14.2.1 The first T293 Plus man and woman shall be known as the 2024 Techno 293 Plus Open ASIAN Champion.
- 14.2.2 The first T293 Plus Youth man and woman shall be known as the 2024 Techno 293 Plus Youth ASIAN Champion.
- 14.2.3 The first T293 Junior boy and girl shall be known as the 2024 Techno 293 Junior ASIAN Champion.
- 14.2.4 The first T293 Youth boy and girl shall be known as the 2023 Techno 293 Youth ASIAN Champion.
- 14.2.5 The first T293 U13 division competitor shall be known as the 2023 Techno 293 U13 ASIAN Champion.
- 14.3 Apart from the Open Division, winners of each division shall only be entitled to prizes within their respective division.

15. OFFICIAL CEREMONIES

Competitors are requested to attend the event's social functions; however, the organising authority may refuse entry to those whose standard of attire is not commensurate with the occasion.

16. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk, see WCR 4 -Decision to Race. 17. INSURANCE

Each participating board shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.

In registering for the event, competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproduction of them, taken during the period of the event, for the said Event as defined in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions in which he/she participates without compensation.
