



Notification To Manufacturers and sailors
Addendum To Division 2 Class Measurement Rules

- The International Displacement Division of Sailboards (Division II) is a single-handed development class that continues to develop bringing new equipment every year.
- Newly manufactured boards and sails are subject to full measurement check according to ID2CA Class measurement rules.
- It is manufacturers and sailors' responsibility to ensure that equipment that they are planning to use for racing fully complies with Class rules.
- Only Measurers officially recognized by International or National Authority of the country in which the measurement is undertaken are entitled to measure a sailboard, its mast, sail and other equipment. If no such bodies exist, the ID2CA or IWA may appoint a Measurer.
- Measurement covers dimensions, weight, appendices of the sailboard as well as safety related requirements (floatability, leash, 15m tow line, towing device, including life west, etc.).
 - Floatability: Personal flotation device that shall conform to the minimum standard of ISO 12402-5 (level 50), or as specified in the SI's.
- Equipment that is found not compliant may be denied access to racing.
- ID2CA Class and Measurement rules must be read carefully.
