1 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the <u>Racing Rules of Sailing Windsurfing Fleet Racing Edition</u> (WCR) for WS classes, RRS Appendix WF applies for the WingFoil class.
- 1.2 The Class Rules of the participating classes.
- 1.3 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race, Sailing Instructions, and any other document governing the event, the Sailing Instructions will take precedence. This changes WCR/RRS 63.7.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING

Boards may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. World Sailing Regulation 20 'Advertising Code' shall apply.

3 CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

- 3.1 The participating **classes** and divisions shall be:
- 3.1.1 **Techno 293** Youth Boy and Girl; Junior Boy and Girl, Minim Boy and Girl
- 3.1.2 **Techno 293 Plus** Open
- 3.1.3 Raceboard Open, Women, Masters, Grandmasters, Veterans
- 3.1.4 **Slalom** Open
- 3.1.5 Wing Foil Open
- 3.2 Age Divisions:
- 3.2.1 Minim is under 13 years of age (U13) on 31 December in the year of competition.
- 3.2.2 Junior is under 15 years of age (U15) on 31 December in the year of competition.
- 3.2.3 Youth is under 17 years of age (U17) on 31 December in the year of competition.
- 3.2.4 A Master shall be a competitor who reached the age of 40 on 31 December of the previous year.
- 3.2.5 A Grandmaster shall be a competitor who reached the age of 50 on 31 December of the previous year.
- 3.2.6 A Veteran shall be a competitor who reached the age of 60 on 31 December of the previous year.
- 3.3 A minimum of 5 competitors is required to constitute a division.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 All entries shall comply with World Sailing Regulation 19-Eligibility Code.
- 4.2 Competitors shall be members of a National Class Association which is a paid up member of the relevant international class association, or of the IWA. Membership formalities can be completed on site.
- 4.3 Eligible competitors may enter by registration on the ČSJ website (https://www.sailing.cz/en/registrations/242108) no later than 10.05.2024 12:00 or completing application form at the event site at the time of registration.

The following shall be presented upon registration:

- Each boat must confirm registration in the event with the captain's signature on the list
 of registered competitors or on the completed application form. For competitors under
 the age of 18, these documents must be signed by a responsible person (coach or
 parent) and completed <u>Parental Permission Form</u>.
- Proof of age
- Czech competitors shall provide ČSJ license for year 2024 and valid health check if it is not entered in the ČSJ database.

Coaches and team support personnel may register for the event. The following shall be

presented upon registration:

- Boat Driving License (if applicable)
- Evidence of valid third-party insurance

5 FEES

5.1 The required entry fee for competitors:

Class Techno 293: 500 CZK (20 EUR)
 Other classes: 600 CZK (25 EUR)

- 5.2 Entry fees shall be paid in cash at registration or when registering on website https://www.sailing.cz/en/registrations/242108
- 5.3 The entry fee does not include fees for entry to the sports field and stay at the YC Dyje resort. This must be paid at the reception according to the valid YC Dyje price list, which is available on the organizer's website (https://www.ycdyje.cz).

6 RACE FORMAT

- 6.1 Czech Supercup is an "open entry" in the discipline *racing* and may include any or all of the formats *course racing*.
- 6.2 Men and women, boys and girls, may race together.
- 6.3 Classes shall have separate starts.
- 6.4 The Techno 293 and Raceboard classes shall race a maximum 4 races per day, in a maximum 8 race series, the Slalom and Wing Foil classes are not limited to the number of races per day and the event is scheduled for a total of 12 races.

7 SCHEDULE

7.2 The results announcement and prize giving will take place as soon as possible after the last race is finished.

8 EQUIPMENT & EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 8.1 Equipment inspections may be made at any time during the event.
- 8.2 Unless otherwise directed by the organizing authority, boards and equipment shall be stored, launched and retrieved from the designated area.

9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions (SI) will be available on the official noticeboard https://www.sailing.cz/en/noticeboard/242108 (a printed copy will be on the bulletin board located near the RC office). SI will be available at registration. Any changes to the SI shall be approved by the Czech Windsurfing Association Representative at the event.

10 COURSES

Courses will be as described in the sailing instructions.

11 PROTEST COMMITTEE

A Protest Committee will be appointed according to WCR/RRS 91(a).

12 SCORING

- 12.1 Scoring will be according to the WCR/RRS Appendix A, except the discards of worst scores it is as follows:
- 12.2 When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of

her race scores.

- 12.3 When 4 to 7 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 12.4 When 8 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.
- 12.5 When 12 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her three worst scores.
- 12.6 For each class, a minimum of 1 race is required for the event to be valid.

13 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be registered at the race office by filling in the relevant registration form. The number of support boats allowed for this event is limited, the boats shall be marked with a number assigned by the organizer in a visible place. The use of motorboats with internal combustion engines with a maximum power of 10 kW is permitted on the Nové Mlýny water area. A registered support boat will be assigned a berth at the jetty, anchoring elsewhere is prohibited. There will be no charge for the mooring of registered support boats. Each boat must have a VHS radio.

14 SAFETY

Every competitor under age 18 and support boat crewmember shall wear a personal flotation device that shall conform to the minimum standard of ISO 12402-5 (level 50), or as specified in the SI's. This changes WCR/RRS 40.

15 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the first three competitors of each properly constituted class/division containing at least 5 competitors.

16 OFFICIAL CEREMONIES

Competitors are requested to attend the event's social functions; however, the organizing authority may refuse entry to those whose standard of attire is not commensurate with the occasion.

17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk, see WCR/RRS 3 Decision to race. The organizing authority or any of their officials or representatives or the sponsors or their officials or representatives will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.

18 INSURANCE

Each participating boat or sailor shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of CZK 9 000 000 per event or the equivalent.

19 RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In registering for the event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority the right in perpetuity to make, use and show from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproduction of them, taken during the period of the event, for the said Event as defined in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions in which he/she participates without compensation.
