

ID2CA Annual Ranking System 2026

ID2CA Sanctioned Events

Each country can propose a number of events with a coefficient of 1. ID2CA compiles a global calendar from these proposals, ensuring a good spread over time and location of the ID2CA members. One high-quality event (e.g. national championship) can yield a higher coefficient of 1.5 points.

The race coefficient for the ranking list shall be written in the Notice of Race for each event and in the events program.

The events and the ranking list are open to all members, in good standing with ID2CA (i.e. current paid up members) who have complied with equipment registration rules.

Every event that was on the ID2CA calendar and that has been sailed counts for the ranking.

Event classification

Events will be classified within four levels:

- Level 1, coefficient 2.2 - World Championships
- Level 2, coefficient 2 - Continental Championships
- Level 3, coefficient 1.5 - National Championships or equivalent
- Level 4, coefficient 1- other standard D2 events

Scoring

The High Point system will be applied. In each event, the first-placed competitor in each category (i.e. A, C,) will receive points equal to 100 multiplied by the race coefficient,

Each place thereafter	minus 4 points	minus 6 points	minus 8 points

- Points are scored as type A OR as type C.
- Type A-scores and type C-scores cannot be added together or mixed.
- A competitor can have two (2) competitor score-lines, one for type C and one for type A.
- At the end of each year, the total of the points **of the five (5) best races** for each competitor will be added in order to classify the athletes in an annual ranking list. (ex-aecquo's are split according Appendix A)
- During the season, all results from ID2CA competitions will be recorded. However, in the final and interim rankings, the results of participants who do not have valid ID2CA membership will not be shown.

Prizes

At the end of the Year, Prizes will be given to sailors that **have participated at 4 or more events** and who have complied with membership and registration.

- First, second and third in Category A
- First, second and third in Category C
- First, second and third Woman
- The Most Faithfull Sailor / Prix de la Combativité: The sailor with the most races in that year and no principal prize. (In case of ex-aecquo: the one with the lowest annual ranking score)
- Best Country: Top Three Sailors (all categories) per Country.

These annual ranking lists will be published on the official website; where they will remain as a permanent record of achievement.
