NOTICE OF RACE

TYF Sailing League Techno 293 3rd Leg races is organized by Turkish Sailing Federation on 09 – 13 March 2026 at the venue of Mark Warner Phokaia Hotel.

1. RULES

- 1.1.** The regatta will be governed by the “rules” as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) (2025-2028) - Windsurfing Fleet Racing Edition (WCR). The applicable T293 Class Rules and this Notice of Race and Additional Sailing Instructions to be published.
- 1.2.** No national authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3.** If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.4.** If there is a conflict between the notice of race, sailing instructions, and any other document governing the event, the sailing instructions will take precedence. This changes WCR 63.7.
- 1.5.** In accordance with the recommendations of World Sailing, competitors of Russian and Belarusian nationality are excluded from this event, entries by such competitors will be rejected and any existing entries by such competitors are cancelled.
- 1.6.** Boards may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

2. NOTICE TO THE COMPETITORS

- 2.1.** All notices to competitors (Organization Committee, Race Committee and Jury) will be posted at the event website <https://yelkenligi.tyf.org.tr>

3. ADVERTISING[NP][DP]

3.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

4. ELIGIBILITY

4.1 The Regatta is open to competitors sailing on Techno 293 U13-U15-U17 classes that fulfill the eligibility requirements stated below.

4.1.1 A T293 U13 shall be under 13 years of age (born in or after 2014, but not later than 2016).

4.1.2 A T293 Junior shall be under 15 years of age (born in or after 2012, but not later than 2015).

4.1.3 A T293 Youth shall be under 17 years of age (born in or after 2010 but not later than 2013).

4.2 For Turkish Sailors :

Competitors shall have valid 2025 license visa and registration will be made through the YBS System on www.tyf.org.tr

4.3 For foreign sailors, entries can be made by sending a mail to sportif@tyf.org.tr

4.4 The on-site registration of each competitor shall not be concluded until the completion of payment has been confirmed by 26 February Juniors/ 02 March Seniors.

4.5 Deadline for the early entry is 02 March 2026 Late entries will have a surcharge of %50 for the entry fee.

4.6 Entry fee is 50 Euros.

5. FORMAT OF THE REGATTA

5.1 Men and women, boys and girls may race together depending upon entry numbers.

5.2 Three races are required to validate the championship for each class.

6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1. A total of 12 races are scheduled for all classes.
- 6.2. No warning signal will be given after 15.00 on the last racing days.

7. MEASUREMENT[DP]

- 7.1. All competitors shall comply with the Class Rules. Equipment inspections may be made at any time during the event.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 8.1. Sailing Instructions will be published on the event website as of 09 March 2026. Other documents governing the race will be published together with the Sailing race instructions.

9. VENUE

10. THE COURSE

Courses will be as described in the sailing instructions.

11. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 11.1. Appendix P will apply for the Fleet races.
- 11.2. Decisions of the jury will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

12. SCORING

- 12.1. Low-point system of RRS App A will be applied.
- 12.2. Scoring will be according to the WCR Appendix A. Scoring for group racing will be specified in the sailing instructions.
- 12.3. When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 12.4. When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

13. SUPPORT BOATS[NP][DP]

- 13.1. Team Support boats shall be registered with the organizing committee and shall be asked to sign a Disclaimer Form upon registration at the venue.
- 13.2. All Coaches and support personnel are required to be equipped with a working VHF radio and to wear their personal buoyancy at all times afload, except when changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment for a short time.
- 13.3. All support boats shall comply with the rules established by the Organising Committee.
- 13.4. Fuel and other consumables shall be paid by the teams using the boat.

- 13.5. Team support boats to be chartered during the Championship days are available from the Organising Committee contact sportif@tyf.org.tr for charter support boat.
- 13.6. Support boats shall stay outside the racing area where the boats are racing from the time of the first warning signal until all boats have finished or the Race Committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.

14. BOAT PARKING

- 14.1 Boats shall not park outside their allocated places.

15. PRIZES

- 15.1. Prizes will be awarded to:
- 15.2. The first three competitors in all classes and categories.

16. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 16.1. Competitors and support team members participate in the series entirely at their own risk and they are reminded of the provisions of RRS 3, Decision to Race. Sailing is, by its nature, an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor and the responsible adult agrees and acknowledges that:
- 16.2. They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- 16.3. They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- 16.4. They accept responsibility for any injury damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omission;
- 16.5. Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event, and they are fit to participate;
- 16.6. The Organising Authority and any other party involved in the organization of the Championship will accept no liability whatsoever for any injury, damage, loss or claim, whether personal or material, incurred by or inflicted to competitors before, during or after the Regatta.
- 16.7. All competitors and support staff will be required to sign liability waiver.
